How should I memorize the Bible?

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. -Joshua 1:8

Read Psalm 119:11

Some people love sports. They memorize the names of their favorite players in their hearts. Why do they do that? The answer is that **you put in your heart the things that are important to you.** If God is important to you, Christian, then you will memorize and think about God's Word. Psalm 119:11 teaches you to hide His Word in your heart so that you might not sin. That is not some magical act that keeps sin away. No, the idea of this verse is that if you truly love God, His Words will be on your mind.

It might work like this:

- You are thinking about Ephesians 6:2 that says, "Honor your Father and Mother."
- You pray, "God, help me to love and obey you."
- Do you think you will want to disobey your parents? No, you love God, and His Word helps you remember how you should do that.

This is an example of the daily devotions and memory question and verse that our Truth Trackers are learning each week. As Psalm 119:11 says, we are encouraging our youth to thoroughly memorize scripture. We have challenged the students to continue to practice all 30 verses as the year continues. There will be prizes awarded to the students who can say the most verses at the end of the year! We're excited to find out who is up for the challenge!

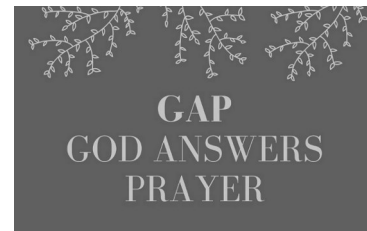
