

Thank you to all who supported, through prayer and finances, the Solid Rock team on their recent mission trip to Oklahoma City. While there, our team of 39 teenagers and 8 leaders worked at 3 different locations.

The Christian Service Center, a ministry looking to show the love of Jesus by providing food and clothing for those in poverty or the homeless, recently purchased a neighboring house to expand their ministry. The house, however, needs complete renovation. As a result, our teams at the center did a wide variety of projects from tearing down a brick chimney, to hanging some siding and insulation, to setting some fence posts in cement.

Another group went to the Life Changes and Wellness Center – a facility designed to help troubled teens and provides produce for local families. Coach Sims works with troubled teens to help them get out of gangs and get their life on track. One of the avenues he uses to help teens is to teach boxing. The other side of the facility was run by miss Clarice who oversees growing produce in their garden to provide for people in their neighborhood. Our groups at the Wellness Center helped with the garden, fixed some gutters, moved tons of dirt, and even built a boxing ring for a tournament.

The last location was our host church, Southpark Baptist Church. This church has hosted missions' groups for 9 weeks during the summer every year since 2013, so we were able to help them with some of their much-needed repairs. Our team fixed soffits, replaced toilets, repaired showers, patched drywall, and did some landscaping.

Each evening, we would gather at our host church to hang out, worship, and be challenged from scripture. It was so fun to see God working in and through the lives of these amazing teenagers. Every experience, from the work to the worship, was used to draw us closer to the Lord and to bring a spirit of unity and comradery among the team members. Thank you so much for the part you played in God's work on this trip.
